Factoring the NSW Government's advice into your U3A's planning.

Further to the advice forwarded yesterday we thought the following would provide further assistance to your Committees.

In continuing our advice that U3A associations must recognise advice from government that may be relevant to their activities, the following will help:

Some of the drop downs on the above will likely have direct relevance to your U3A in its use of venues; a couple of extracts are shown (*and there is much more*):

Physical distancing

- Ensure capacity does not exceed one person per 4 square metres.
- Ensure indoor group activities, such as yoga classes or group counselling sessions, have no more than 20 participants, plus the instructor or facilitator and any assistants, per space and comply with one person per 4 square metres.

Hygiene and cleaning

- Adopt good hand hygiene practices.
- Ensure hand sanitiser is accessible at the venue entry and throughout the facility or ground.
- Ensure bathrooms are well stocked with hand soap and paper towels.
- Provide visual aids above hand wash basins to support effective hand washing.
